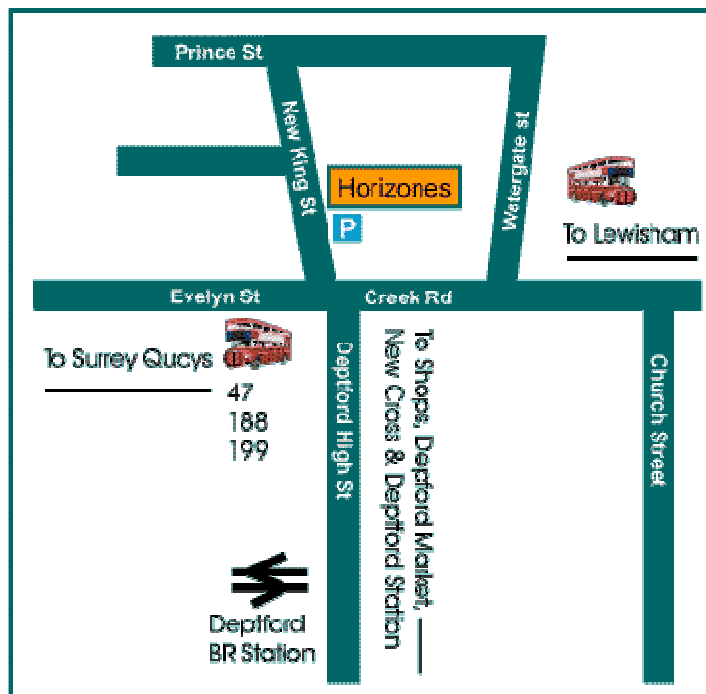

What is CyberZone?

CyberZone is a friendly fun club for disabled children and young people. It provides opportunities to:

- meet other people
- access high quality computer and teaching facilities in a supportive environment
- take part in a range of activities addressing different needs

The club emphasizes having fun, playing games and enjoying learning practical computer skills.

In addition to the computers, the club also provides games consoles, a pool table, table football, indoor and outdoor physical games, dance sessions, and summer trips.

Support is provided by experienced and highly qualified computer tutors, youth workers and support workers.

CyberZone is open to disabled children and young people aged 7-18 years who live in Lewisham. Parents and carers are also welcome. Joining CyberZone is based on a visit to the centre and an informal interview which can take place at any time during the year.
